1. Introduction

To filter your “fix-to-mobile” emails according to your requirements, e.g. for SPAM protection, or to restrict the group of people, who are authorised to send e-mails to your terminal, you can create a black & white list for each SkyFile-account.

- **“Black”-entries:** define terrestrial e-mail addresses or even e-mail domains, which are not permitted to send messages to your terminal(s).
- **“White”-entries:** define terrestrial e-mail addresses or even e-mail domains, which are allowed to send messages to the terminal(s). Once a “white” entry exists, all other unspecified e-mail addresses are automatically “black”, that means, only the "white" list entries are permitted to send e-mails to the respective SkyFile-account(s).

Black & white entries/lists can even be mixed, e.g. if the domain "@charterer.com" is white listed, specific e-mail-addresses like "badperson@charterer.com" can still be black listed!

2. How to set up a black & white-list?

There are 2 ways to administrate the black & white-list from your office:


- a) On a web-page via remote-configuration
Very easy and directly changed on the server
- b) Via a control e-mail from a registered terrestrial e-mail account
b&w-list can be applied to multiple accounts at the same time, furthermore the SkyFile Mail user could change his b&w-list via e-mail from his SkyFile client

2.1 Administration via web-page

- Please activate the option "remote control" with our customer service by email to mobilesat@vizada.com or support.skyfilemail@vizada.com or by phone +33556223231
- go on web page <http://webmail.skyfile.com/cfg.htm>
- enter Master-username/Master-Password of the respective SkyFile account.



- On the left part of the window you find the option “Black&White list”, please select


After changing any configuration data (except the black & white list) and for requesting any files, please do not forget to click on "Send all".

The black&white list is stored directly in the server, changes apply immediately. No transfer is required.

How it works

The black & white list is scanned from top to bottom and matches the trailing part of the address given. Thus more detailed addresses must be above shorter ones.

If there are no entries with "-" (which is most typical, so there is no blacklist), an address not matching a "+" line is denied. An empty list will allow any address.

Use a preceding + to allow or - to deny an address. Entries can be shortened to their domain name or any other trailing part if they should match multiple senders.

- Press "Save": All changes will be applied immediately after pressing this button.

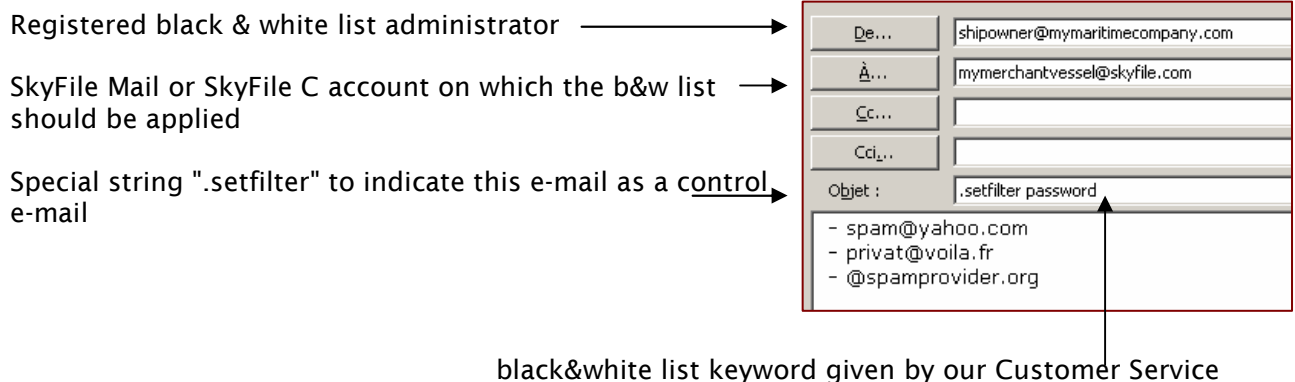
2.2 Administration via a "control e-mail"

Please activate the option "remote control" with our customer service. You need to register one or two e-mail addresses of persons defined as your black & white-list administrators for SkyFile Mail 6.3/SkyFile C accounts.

Our Customer Service will confirm the activation and provide you with a black & white-list keyword to protect you against misuse.

To create a black & white list for your SkyFile accounts, the registered list administrator has to send a control e-mail to your SkyFile-address with the string **".setfilter"** and the black & white-list keyword in the subject-line. The e-mail text of this control e-mail has to contain the black & white list as follows:

- + office@shipowner.de [White-list entry]
- + @charter.com [White-list allowing the whole domain]
- spam@spamnet.com [Black-list entry]



Message-text including the black & white list definition (up to 64 entries)

3. Further details and information:

- The control e-mail itself will not be transferred to the terminal; thus you don't have to pay for it.

- To get the status of your actual black & white list, please send a control e-mail with an empty message-text.

SkyFile Mail 6.3 / SkyFile C will reply on this e-mail with the actual valid black & white list for your account.

- To delete the entire black & white list, you have to enter the word "erase" in the message-text of the control e-mail.



- If you only want to add one or several black & white list entries to an existing list, please enter ".addfilter" instead of ".setfilter" in the subject line of the control e-mail. In this case the black & white list entries in the message text will only be added to the existing list!
